

Bulk Garbage Drop-off

TOWN OF HERMAN, DODGE COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town of Herman will be holding a FALL BULK GARBAGE DROP-OFF day at the Town of Herman Recycling Center, N6131 Town Hall Road on OCTOBER 19, 2013 during regular recycling center hours for Town of Herman residents ONLY. Proof of ID may be required.

An extra large dumpster will be available at the recycling center for drop-off of bulk items. A scrap metal bin will be available as usual. Tires are accepted but not in the bulk drop-off bin and are subject to specific fees based on size of tire.

Items eligible for bulk drop-off are:

- Furniture
- Rolled carpeting
- Cabinets
- Countertops
- Mattresses/bed springs
- Non metal doors
- Wood windows
- Play equipment
- Appliances that do not contain Freon and are not electronic

Excluded Items:

- Construction or Business Waste
- Freon containing appliances, TVs, microwaves, or electronic goods
- Batteries
- Used oil, grease, filters or rags containing oil and grease

Information of where these items may be disposed of will be available at the recycling center. Ask attendants on duty. Information about bulk drop-off and proper disposal of excluded items will be available on the town website in the coming weeks or call the clerk, Diane Beine at (920) 387-9322.
